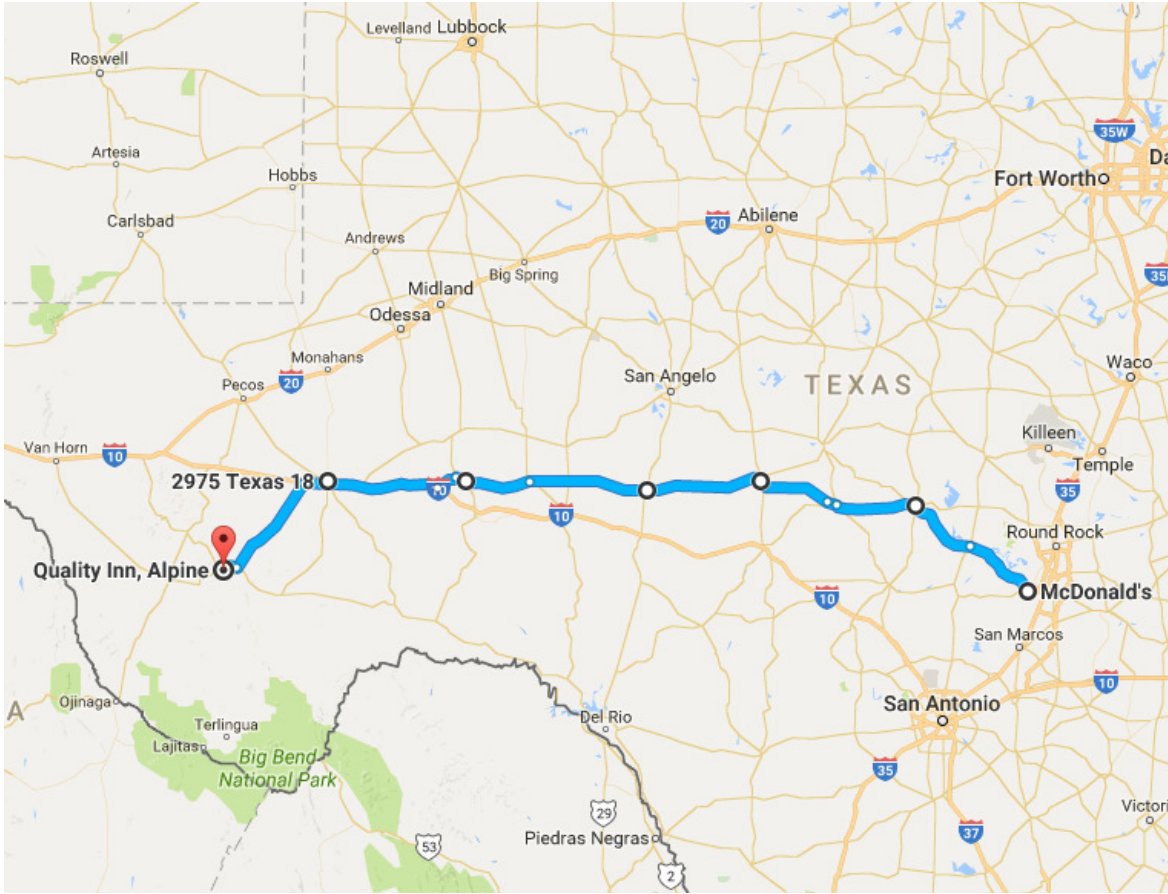
7am - Arrive no later than 6:45am with a full tank and empty bladder.

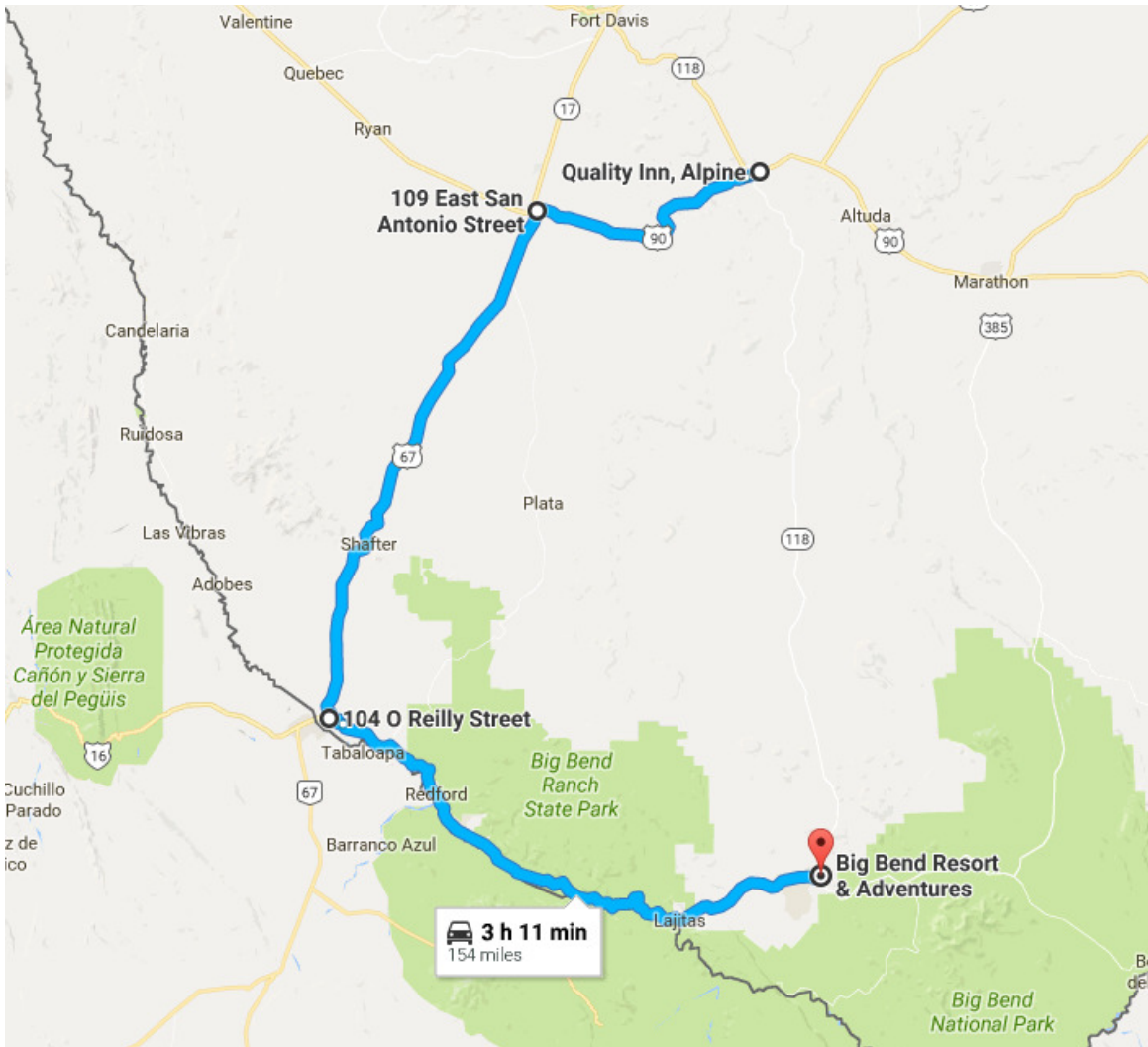

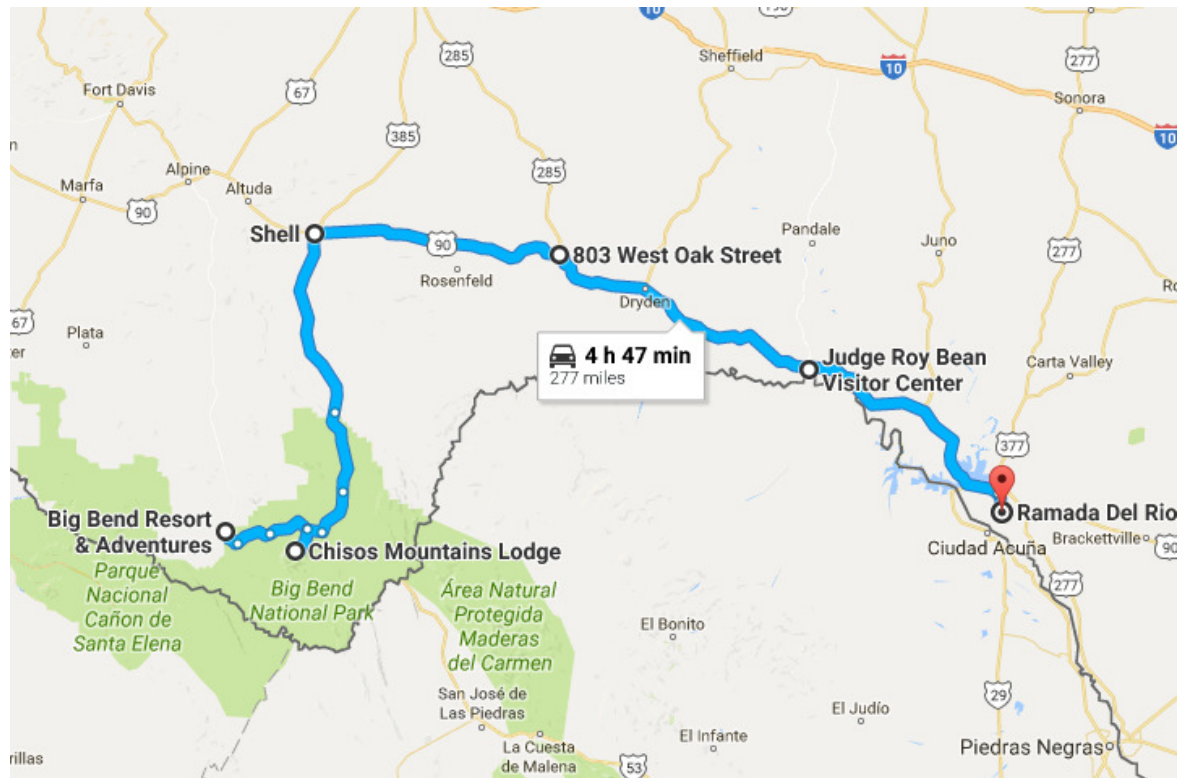
Total distance: 277mi
